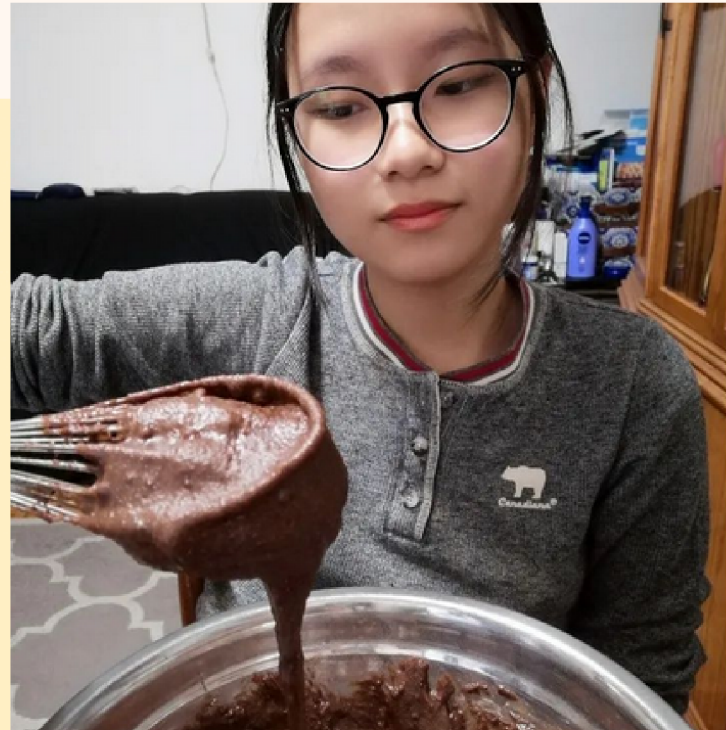


Good Shepherd Ministries Needs Your Baked Goods!
